<p>There are two types of Special Events that fall under the jurisdiction of the Vice President, Special Events.</p> <p>A Special Event for the Potomac Pedalers Touring Club is defined as either of the following:</p> <p>A ride that takes place that includes a major focus beyond cycling. This may include any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an organized gathering for food and/or beverages • an overnight stay • watching a live, televised or recorded cycling event • photo opportunities • sightseeing off the bike. <p>A non-riding event that is organized for the primary benefit and enjoyment of PPTC members. These events may include an organized gathering for food and/or beverages, watching a live televised or recorded cycling event, photo opportunities, and sightseeing off the bike. Special events include the Annual Meeting and Volunteer Dinner.</p> <p>The Century and accompanying Century Weekend events fall under the auspices of the Vice President, Century.</p>
